Same Day Surgery, Recovery Room, Medical Surgical floors and the Infusion Center are our most active recipients. Intensive care, OB, long term care and the psychiatric unit also request HT. Employees and nursing staff are our best advocates, and when possible, take advantage of our service. Nurses who are also HT volunteers are able to use their skills on a "not to interfere with other duties" basis, and with their supervisor's approval. The physician response has been exceptional.

welcoming all employees of KCH to a day of HT sessions. 9 months after our original presentation to Administration and Med Surg Staff, we had an approved program, "pain management, a division of Surgical Service". Includes: Policies and Procedures, JCAHO competency checklist, a graph to show progress, informational flyers, evaluation cards to be placed in a patient's chart, and 2 coordinators to oversee and precept new volunteers

Is There Marketing for HT Services: No. We write the forms as needed: informational flyers offered at nursing stations and in admission packets, colorful flyers in elevators, occasional news articles appear in the local paper and in hospital monthly newsletter. Most of our marketing is "word of mouth" from patients themselves. We have received wonderful letters in support of our program.

Other information you would like to include about your facility: Kona Hospital is the first hospital in HHSC to create a HT program. Kona Hospital Foundation offers a grant of \$200.00 towards registration fees of HT level in exchange for volunteering doing HT 8 hours a month for a year.
